### About EAGC

The Eastern Africa Grain Council (EAGC). EAGC is a regional, not-for-profit council of firms and organizations in the grain value that is “the leading voice of the grain industry in Africa” whose mandate is “to facilitate efficient structured, inclusive, sustainable and profitable grain trade” through various interventions and programs that include; policy research and advocacy, provision of market information, training and capacity building as well as developing structured grain trading systems.

The *Sustainable African Value-Chain Initiative (SAVI)* is a joint initiative between the Confederation of Danish Industry (DI) in Denmark and EAGC in Kenya.

SAVI aims to **strengthen the sustainability and competitiveness of Kenyan businesses** by helping local companies in the grain value chain to accelerate their work with green transition. In Kenya, EAGC will lead national implementation, focusing on **company-level carbon accounting, decarbonization, ESG reporting, EUDR compliance, water efficiency and value-chain collaboration for sustainability.**

The Project Manager & Sustainability Lead will coordinate and lead SAVI activities in Kenya for EAGC. The position combines **general project management responsibilities** with **technical facilitation and implementation with companies.** In the role the candidate will support Kenyan companies (EAGC members) in successfully achieving capacity to account their carbon emissions, creating decarbonization and water strategies, reporting and improving their ESG performance, and facilitating sustainability dialogues across selected companies value chains.

### Required qualifications

#### Education

- University degree in **environmental management, engineering, business sustainability,** or related field.
- Postgraduate degree or professional certification in **climate change, ESG reporting, project management or development management** is an advantage.



## Professional Experience

- **4 – 5 years’ experience** in sustainability or environment, industrial development, or climate-related projects.
- Demonstrated experience in **supporting companies in carbon accounting, making decarbonisation strategies or climate-action plans.**
- Strong ability to facilitate interactive workshops and company session on sustainability, decarbonisation, water and/or ESG integration.
- Proven ability to **develop or review ESG reports** and advise on sustainability indicators and disclosure standards (GRI, SASB, or equivalent).
- Experience facilitating **multi-stakeholder dialogues or value-chain partnerships** involving business, government, and international partners.
- Familiarity with **donor-funded programme management** (EU, DANIDA, GIZ, UN, etc.).
